
1. URGENT RESPONSE THROUGH VICTIM EMPOWERMENT & SUPPORT

- Do you know someone that needs urgent intervention?



6. HOW TO REPORT A CASE






1. Call, SMS, send a direct message (DM) to any of our social media pages or visit our offices





3. A case will be opened and you will be assigned an LKF case number


