LGBTQIA+ refers to

L = Lesbian - A woman who is attracted to other women.

G = Gay - A man who is attracted to other men.

B = Bisexual - A person who is attracted to more than one gender.

T = Transgender – A person whose gender identity differs from the sex they were assigned at birth.

Q = Queer - A person who does not fit into the usual ideas of gender and sexuality.

I = Intersex - A person who is born with body parts that do not fit typical ideas of male or female.

A = Asexual – A person who does not feel sexual attraction to others.

+ = Plus – This means there are more identities that are part of the LGBTQIA+ group.
